ACADEMIC PROFILE

FACULTY/STAFF: All faculty teach in the discipline for which they are professionally prepared. On average, half of the faculty has earned post-graduate degrees.

SCHEDULE: Two-semester system with a rotating block schedule. Each class meets four times every 7 day cycle for 70 minutes each classroom session.

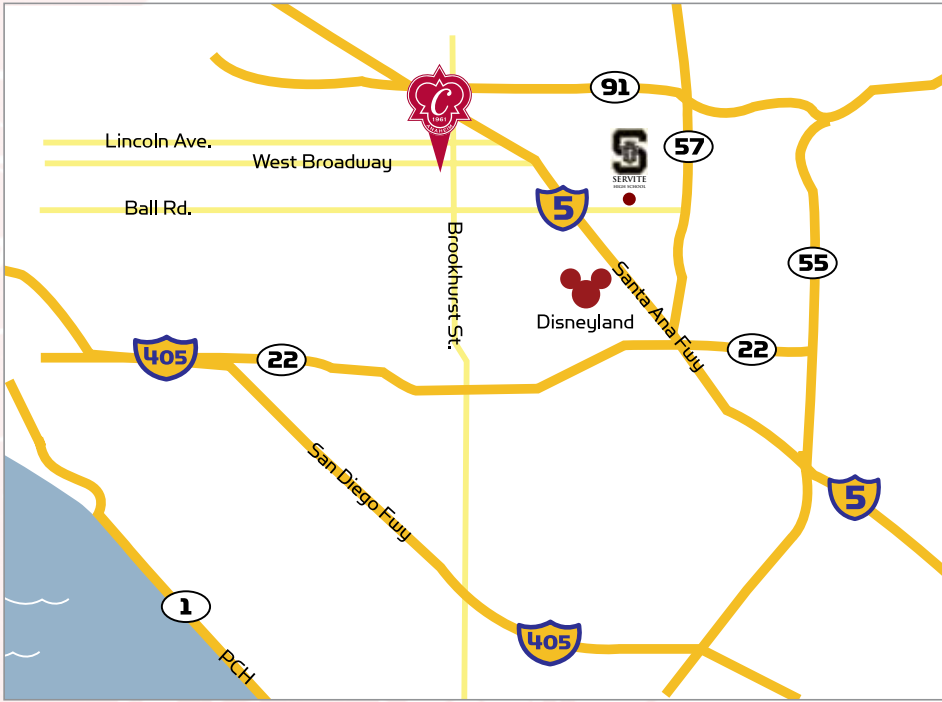
FOREIGN LANGUAGES OFFERED: Latin, Mandarin, and Spanish

TECHNOLOGY: Smart Boards in every classroom; iPad 2s for classroom use; Computer labs; Online resource library.

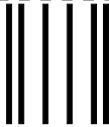

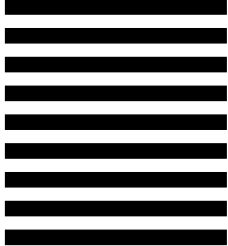
