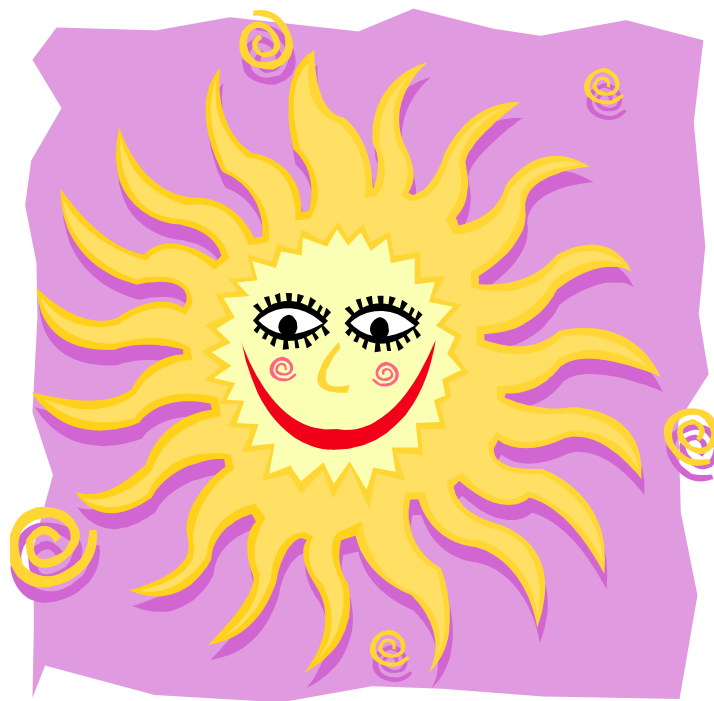

COURSES FOR ENRICHMENT

- **English Composition/High School Study Skills** 8:30 am – 10:30 am

Designed to build confidence and competency in writing, this course will survey all major aspects of language skills. Through extensive writing in a variety of forms (narrative, persuasive, expository, etc.), students will not only be acclimated to general concepts as a class, but will also receive individual attention for specific grammar and other usage problems. Emphasis will also be placed on exercising self and peer evaluation tools. The Study Skills portion of the class will offer the student the opportunity to identify his/her own learning style and how to apply it to the overall high school curriculum. Topics covered include developing study skills for home and school environments, preparing for quizzes and tests, active reading and listening, effective note taking, library research methods for papers, themes and projects, goal setting, time management and stress management.

MATHEMATICS

- **Pre-Algebra** 10:45 am – 12:45 pm

Designed to decrease math anxiety for students preparing to take Algebra I in the fall, this course includes a review of arithmetic operations, fractions, decimals, percents, ratio and proportion, factors and the Metric System. Introductory algebraic concepts presented include operations with integers, order of operations, variables and expressions, evaluation of algebraic expressions, equations and graphing equations with two variables.
