



Holy Child Scholarship Application Procedures 2011-2012

Each year, Connelly awards 3 major merit-based scholarships in the form of tuition remission. These scholarships include one full four-year tuition scholarship and two partial four-year tuition scholarships (worth half of the tuition amount each year). They are awarded to students who demonstrate excellence in all aspects of self. Please note that only candidates with completed application files will be considered. Guidelines are listed below. (3 awards available: one four-year tuition award and two partial four-year tuition awards.)

The recipient of The Holy Child Scholarship will possess a positive attitude, should be a strong example of the development of the whole person and demonstrate strength in all areas of school and community involvement. These may include academics, community service, athletics, leadership, spirituality, co-curricular activities, and arts.

The following must be submitted to the Admissions Office by their respective deadlines:

Guidelines:

- Apply for **Early Decision** by submitting all Application for Admission items to Cornelia Connelly High School by **Monday, December 6, 2010**.
- Score in the 90th National Percentile on the High School Placement Test, taken at Connelly on January 22, 2011.
- Official Transcripts Showing at least a B+ Average on 7th Grade and First Semester 8th Grade Grades.
- A One-page Typed Essay. Topic: "The Unique Qualities That I Will Bring to Connelly" due by **Friday, January 28, 2011**.
- Academic or Extracurricular Letter of Recommendation due by **Friday, January 28, 2011**. Please note that this letter is in addition to the *Academic Reference* that is found in the application packet. These recommendations must be from two different sources. Please **do not** use the *Academic Reference* form in the application packet for this recommendation.
- Completed Scholarship Application Form and Cover Sheet due **Friday, January 28, 2011**.
- Interview scheduled with the Scholarship Committee on February 5, 2011. Please contact Connelly's Office of Admission for an appointment.
