- **B**) Please also attach an un-graded writing sample, 1 page or less, from a recent assignment. It does not need to be a review, but no poetry, please. Re-applying critics do not need to attach a writing sample.
- C) Return this application and your writing sample to Tri-School Theatre no later than 4:00 pm, **September 5<sup>th</sup>**. Late applications will not be considered under any circumstances, but you are encouraged to turn in your application early.
- 1) Please describe your involvement/experience with theatre. You may include experiences as an audience member, performer, technical worker, student, etc.
- 2) Please describe yourself as a writer and English student. Are you involved or experienced in journalism?
- 3) Do you consider yourself a mature and tactful writer? No sarcasm or harsh criticism will be accepted from any review writer, in spoken word or in written form.
- 4) You will need reliable access to the internet, an e-mail address, and must be able to meet strict deadlines the weekend of the performances you attend. Will you be able to meet this requirement?
- 5) Are you willing to commit to seeing and reviewing at least  $\underline{\mathbf{8}}$  shows throughout the year? The shows are located across Orange County, and you will need to write a review by the deadline after each one. The dates will be provided/offered to you as soon as possible. They will mostly be Thursday, Friday, and Saturday evening performances. You are allowed to see each show only once.
- 6) Do you believe that you can keep in confidence all comments made by critics during post-show sessions?
- 7) Are you able to provide reliable transportation for yourself to and from performances?
- 8) Are you able to attend the Mandatory Critic Training Session Saturday, September 26<sup>th</sup> at Fullerton Union High School? Sessions will be scheduled some time between 8:00am-5:00pm.

### TRI-SCHOOL THEATRE CONTRACT/AGREEMENT For: Cappies Critics Program

#### TO BE READ AND SIGNED BY STUDENT AND PARENT/GUARDIAN

- 1. TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION: Students must provide their own transportation all required shows, as well as to the training session and any additional shows they plan to attend. Students will be assigned to 4 team shows, and must sign up for 4 additional shows. If a student cannot attend a show for which he or she is signed up, he or she must ask the lead critic and mentor for permission to decline the show, and then arrange through CIS online to decline and sign up to attend another qualified Cappies show.
- 2. REVIEWS AND ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS: Tri-School Cappies Critics must attend and review at least 8 shows. They must submit a review written according to the guidelines for each show by the deadline. Critics must attend the voting day at the end of the year. Critics are strongly encouraged to attend and review additional shows. All Cappies shows are free to critics who are assigned to review them. There are limited openings for critics at each Cappies show, so sign up early. Check back often to see if space becomes available for a full show.

Critics must check with lead critic and mentor before declining an assigned show. Critics will be charged \$15 if they do not attend a show and do not decline it, or if they decline a show less than 48 hours in advance. Critics must be on time (30-45 min early) for each show. Critics who are late will be turned away from the show, or will have to purchase a ticket. If a review is not submitted on time, the critic must pay a fine of \$15. Critics may not see a Cappies show more than once. All fees paid are sent to the school whose show you missed or did not review. Tri-School does not keep any of these fees.

- 3. PARTICIPATION FEE: \$ 55 Non-Refundable Participation Fee payable to Tri-School (Due by October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015). This fee is applied to the Tri-School Team Fee charged by Cappies, and is used to provide refreshments for visiting Cappies Teams and a nominal mentor stipend. Tri-School does not keep this fee as profit.
- **SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS:** Students must have a 2.0 G.P.A. for the current quarter in order to participate in the Cappies program. The contract includes academic counselor's signature. Students participating in any Tri-School Theatre program are bound by the policies of their individual schools. In particular, please pay special attention to the Sexual Harassment policy appropriate behavior must be exhibited at all times, as well as the Attendance Policy students MUST be in attendance at school for at least 2 block periods or 4 regular class periods in order to attend extra curricular activities this includes Cappies performances.
- **5. ALCOHOL/DRUG POLICIES:** Use of alcohol or drugs is STRICTLY PROHIBITED. Any student suspected of drinking or being under the influence of any substance will be referred to the Dean or Principal of that student's school and PARENTS WILL BE CONTACTED IMMEDIATELY and the student will be sent home.
- 6. CONSEQUENCES: Students who fail to adhere to these policies or do not fulfill their requirements as a critic may be removed from the team. If it is early enough in the year, they will be replaced by a waitlisted student. They will not be able to apply as a critic again. Critics who do not complete the program year are not eligible for awards, and may jeopardize Tri-School's eligibility for awards.

CAPPIES SHOWS ARE OFTEN LATE NIGHT EVENTS, AS THERE IS A DISCUSSION PERIOD AFTER THE SHOW, AND SOME OF THE SHOWS ARE IN SOUTH ORANGE COUNTY. STUDENTS MUST ADHERE TO ALL DRIVING LAWS. STUDENTS ARE ASKED TO BRING CELL PHONES TO CALL PARENTS AT THE END OF THE PERFORMANCE. IF YOUR STUDENT DOES NOT DRIVE, PLAN TO PICK UP YOUR STUDENT APPROXIMATELY 3 HOURS AFTER THE START TIME OF THE SHOW. PLEASE BE PROMPT.
