So What IS Comedy Sportz High School League?

Have you ever seen the show “Whose Line is it Anyway?” Well, you’ll be learning how to play improv games like those, and competing against other ‘actletes’ in matches, which are performances. The matches are refereed and the audience decides who wins with their applause. We don’t keep track of who wins or loses, and we switch around the teams often. We also play matches against teams from other schools!

This is open to anyone who wants to give it a shot: athletes, actors, etc.

The greatest thing about Comedy Sportz is that

YOU DON’T HAVE TO BE FUNNY.

You just have to be positive, enthusiastic, and want to have a good time.

We’ll teach you the rest.

Team members will be scheduled to perform at matches after they are approved by the professional Comedy Sportz LA coach. No student will perform until he or she is approved. Being cast on last year’s team does not guarantee a spot on this team. However, experienced players with good attitudes are usually re-cast.

If this sounds like fun...

1) Have your parents and academic counselor fill out the attached contract. Then, check your calendar, and fill out the conflict sheet. (We need to know that you can come to the practices each week.)

2) Come to the audition in comfortable clothing, with your contract and conflict form filled out, and be ready to have a good time. We are looking for people who are positive and enthusiastic! You do not need to prepare anything else for the audition. How cool is that?

TRI-SCHOOL THEATRE CONTRACT/AGREEMENT

IT IS VERY IMPORTANT TO LIST ALL CONFLICT DATES AND TIMES ON
THE CONTRACT.**

Please consider all outside commitments such as:

Kairos, Confirmation, Close-Up, Retreats, Class Trips, After School Classes, Choir, Vacations, SAT/ACT tests, Reunions, Birthdays, Sports, other Family Commitments.

PLEASE BE THOROUGH IN YOUR PLANNING. Flexibility and Availability of schedule WILL impact casting.

- PARENTS/GUARDIANS:** Due to the nature of creating a Comedy Sportz Team, we must ask your careful consideration and cooperation in scheduling family trips and events which conflict with rehearsal schedule. Please discuss your personal calendar with your child and list all conflicts on the contract. **THESE EVENTS MUST BE LISTED ON YOUR CHILD'S CONFLICT SHEET. Absences from rehearsal may result in his/her dismissal from a match and/or from the cast.**
- PARTICIPATION FEE: \$ 250 Non-Refundable Participation Fee (Due by September 29th, 2015)** This fee includes all coaching, workshops, and referees for the year, plus team shirts. Participation fees must be paid before a student can begin another activity at Tri-School.
- SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS:** Students must have a 2.0 G.P.A. for the current quarter in order to participate in the show. The contract includes academic counselor's signature. Students participating in any Tri-School Theatre Production are bound by the policies of their individual schools. In particular, please pay special attention to the Sexual Harassment policy – appropriate behavior must be exhibited at all times, as well as the Attendance Policy - students **MUST** be in attendance at school for at least 2 block periods or 4 regular class periods in order to attend extra curricular activities – this includes rehearsals and performances.
- ALCOHOL/DRUG POLICIES:** Use of alcohol or drugs is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED**. Any student suspected of drinking or being under the influence of any substance at rehearsal or performance will be referred to the Dean or Principal of that student's school and **PARENTS WILL BE CONTACTED IMMEDIATELY** and the student will be sent home.
- REHEARSALS AND SHOWS WILL END PROMPTLY AT THE TIME INDICATED ON THE SCHEDULE. PLEASE PICK UP YOUR CHILD ON TIME. PLEASE RESPECT THE TIME AND SCHEDULES OF TRI-SCHOOL EMPLOYEES AND PICK UP YOUR STUDENT ON TIME.**
