Advanced Placement United States History (APUSH)

Welcome to APUSH! We will have a great year together! In order to maintain the accelerated pace of the course, the following readings are required:

All of the questions from the lesson packets are to be typed on a separate sheet of paper. Clearly identify the lesson and question numbers you are answering. Lessons for the novels are available on the Connelly website.

- 1. Uncle Tom's Cabin by Harriet Beecher Stowe.
 - a. Read the novel
 - b. Complete all lessons (1,2,8,9,10,11). These are due the FIRST day of class.
- 2. The Jungle by Upton Sinclair.
 - a. Read the novel
 - b. Complete all lessons (1,3,4,5). These are also due on the FIRST day of class. Be sure to read "Notes to the Teacher" when included: you may find them helpful.

3. American Pageant / American Pageant Workbook

- 13th Edition, Houghton Mifflin School, 2006
 - a. Read the first three chapters and complete the corresponding workbook chapters.

When you begin school, you will be tested on all of the readings. A passing score is required to remain in APUSH. Failure of any of these tests may result in transfer to regular U.S. History. Pace yourself on the reading. Finish one novel in June, the other in July, and complete your textbook work in August. Do not procrastinate. If, at any time during the summer, you change your mind about enrollment in AP United States History, please inform the school.
