<u>Seniors:</u> Most of your remaining applications are due by February 1st. Be sure all necessary materials (SAT scores, etc.) have been sent to your chosen colleges. Fill out and send in the FAFSA. <u>All financial aid/</u>loans are dependent on this. Don't **get senioritis: colleges want to see strong second semester grades!** If you are thinking of changing your second semester schedule, be sure to check with the colleges you have applied to first. Congrats to those of you who have already heard from a college/university!

Juniors: It's time to start meeting with me to start your college application process. I will be scheduling you during free blocks, during lunch/conference, before or after school and if necessary during class. Start looking at colleges this spring. Don't get hooked on just one school - it might not be a realistic choice. Your ideas about what you want will change over time. Don't obsess over the college process - you still need to do well in school. Focus on your academics but find an activity you love. Start forming good relationships with teachers now so you have people you can ask to write recommendations for you. Connelly is offering a SAT test prep course on campus for the March Test. (See Flyer) Plan on taking the SAT Reasoning Test in March or May, and some SAT Subject Tests and maybe the ACT in April June.
