## Disneyland Grad Nite Guidelines 12 pm Wed. June $3^{rd}$ – 2:00 am Thurs. June $4^{th}$ , 2015

The Disneyland Grad Nite allows admission during the day into both California Adventure and Disneyland which are simultaneously open to the public until 10 p.m. at which time all other non-Grad Nite guests will be cleared from the parks and all graduates will be directed to Disney California Adventures where the Grad Nite party runs from 10 p.m. to 2 a.m.

Due to the very early pick up required, we have arranged for the bus to pick us up at Disneyland and return us to Connelly at 2 a.m. where girls will sleep until pick up time which is at 9 a.m. No girls will be allowed to leave until 9 a.m. at the earliest to assure they have some sleep before getting on the road.

<u>Please note:</u> Disneyland passes will not be honored after 10 p.m. but until then pass holders could spend from noon to 10 p.m. with classmates, but they will have to leave the park at 10:00 pm and their transportation would be up to them. Only those staying for the Grad Nite festivities will be able to travel with by bus to and from Connelly.

## Here are the Disneyland Rules:

- No backpacks (including purse-sized), logo clothing(including school), torn, unsafe or revealing clothing/footwear
- No knives, chemical irritants, medications, food, beverages, lighters or tobacco products may be taken into Disneyland by students. Prescription medications should be given to chaperones, except inhalers. Purses will be searched at the entrance.
- Pictures will be taken throughout the park and evening.
- Alcohol and drugs are strictly prohibited. In the case of anyone appearing "under the influence," parents will be called to pick up their student(s).
- Proper behavior and appropriate attire is expected of all students. Respect is to be paid to all chaperones.
- The school has the right to dismiss a student from the event for inappropriate behavior or attire.

## All Connelly High School policies are in effect.

A permission slip is required of each student and guest.
