

## **Guidelines for a successful and meaningful Service Learning project:**

**Your project will be presented during your Senior Exit Interview. A bound physical report is *no longer required* but any visuals you have for this project will only enhance your presentation.**

1. All reflection papers must be typed: use 12 to 14 fonts, double space, with proper margins (MLA Format). Please proof-read before submitting for review. This needs to be a least 1 ½ pages.
2. Be creative in your visual presentation: You've had a lot of experience with iPads and Apps to present an innovative and resourceful presentation.
3. Elements of Presentation:
  - A lead statement that explains briefly the essence of your project, you may use a meaningful quotation, a biblical passage, a poetic metaphor, etc. to tie in the meaning of doing service for others.
  - Maybe speak about your **Goals** after choosing this area of service, then discuss your (or your group's **plan**) to achieve the goals and a description of what each of you did. If you did do a group project, name each person in your group, how much time you committed to this service, and who your contact person was.
  - Discuss in detail the description of the organization, the people they serve, and any other pertinent information about the organization.
  - *Each person in your group (if you are in a group) is to write her own individual reflection on this project* and how the service-learning affected you personally and how it benefited the people you served. Include what you learned, what you liked, what you might have done differently, how the experience changed you. Also, the reflection should include the importance of doing service-learning in the community and whether you will continue to do service for others in the future after you graduate.
  - Finally, include any correspondences you may have gathered. For example, introductions, thank yous, either to you or your thank you to the organization for letting you take part. Include any visuals of pamphlets, flyers, pictures (add these in your presentation for exit interview).
  - There are sample physical reports in the Campus Ministry Office for you to review if desired because there was once a requirement to turn in a physical report. These will help you in your presentation.
