Those planning on attending a UC and with less than 680 on the SAT Writing section must take the Analytical Writing Placement Examination on Saturday, May 10. <u>Juniors:</u> Plan on taking appropriate **SAT Subject Tests** in May or June. You may register online. See Mrs. Anderson if you need help. **ACT** applications are also available. You may also walk on; see me to find out how and where. You did a great job of seeing me to discuss your college plans but now it's time to make appointments to register for senior classes. Many of you have already taken the **SAT Reasoning Test** or **ACT** and done well. If you didn't do as well as you had hoped, plan on taking a prep course in the summer.

Frosh/Sophomores: You too should plan on taking appropriate **SAT Subject Tests** in June. You may register online or use applications available in the College Center.

<u>All Students:</u> Loads of information on summer opportunities across the country is available in the College Center. Come check it out! You can take classes earning Honors credit at many UC campuses. See Mrs. Anderson for more information. Or you can take online courses through their College Prep Online program. You can accelerate with an AP/Honors course or make up courses for credit. All courses meet the UC a-g requirements. More information is available in the College Center or go to www.uccp.org.
